Schedule

- Courses are available for teachers employed by any of Florida's School Districts.
- Six "entry points" (every 8 weeks) are offered per year, providing a flexible timeline for course work completion.
- All courses are offered fully online.
- Face to face contact is available by appointment with the instructor when available.
- All courses are available for 3 undergraduate credit.
