Institutional Data – Faculty Information

A. Student to Faculty Ratio – 8:1

B. Faculty Data

In the counts below, administrators and staff also providing instruction are counted as affiliate faculty. Note that many faculty provide instruction in more than one program: a number of undergraduate faculty provide instruction in general education courses for both the B.S. and B.A. programs; some graduate faculty serve both the Ed.D. and Ph.D. programs; similarly, some faculty serve both the Psy.D. and M.A. program in Clinical Mental Health Counseling. For the purposes of this report, a terminal degree is either a Master of Fine Arts degree or a post-masters certificate. Note: Because deans and staff providing instruction are included in these tables and because affiliate faculty serving more than one program are counted more than once, the resulting totals are not the same as for the IPEDS Human Resources survey, where individuals may be counted once and in only one employment category.
